ATI Testing of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS):

All the following requirements must be met:

- ATI TEAS scores are to be submitted by the application period's deadline. Applicants who do not submit TEAS scores by the deadline will not be considered for admission and must wait until the next enrollment period for the nursing program.
- ATI TEAS score shall not be more than 1 year old.
- One (1) point per testing category (Reading Comprehension, Math, Science & Language usage) is required.
- A minimum of 4 points must be achieved to be considered for admission. ****Although 4 points is the minimum requirement, to increase your chances, it is best if you score higher****

Reading Comprehension	80 or above = 2 pts;	56 - 79 = 1 pt.;	55 or below = 0 pt.
Mathematics	80 or above = 2 pts;	66 - 79 = 1 pt.;	65 or below = 0 pt.

Healthcare Work Experience: The admission committee offers applicants the opportunity to strengthen their application by awarding points for healthcare work experience. Healthcare work experience, **although not a requirement** when applying to the nursing program, may assist applicants to earn additional points towards the application process. Examples of healthcare experience include the following: Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), Patient Care Technician (PCT), Medical Assistant (MA), Certified Pharmacy Technician, Phlebotomist, Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN/LPN), or other Board-Certified healthcare/patient care professionals. Proof of certification must be provided and subject to verification before points are awarded.
