- ✓ Biographical letter of no more than one typed page which should include the following:
- ✓ Personal information you choose to share about your family or background Educational goals
- ✓ Letter of acceptance from a 4 year college or university in Bexar County and date you will be attending.
- ✓ Minimum of three letters of recommendation--two should be from professors, one from other school personnel or employers, not from family members or personal friends.
- ✓ Official undergraduate transcript, including most recent semester completed
- ✓ Copy of Tax form

All scholarship money is paid directly to the four year college or university in Bexar County which the students will attend.
