**Mary M. Dennis**  
Mayor, City of Live Oak

Born in Newton, Mississippi, Mayor Mary M. Dennis moved to San Antonio, Texas, at age 15. She has served as Mayor of the City of Live Oak since 2010 and was re-elected in 2022. As the city's first African-American Mayor, she is dedicated to fostering unity across diverse backgrounds and making government more efficient and accessible. Before her election, she served on the Planning and Zoning Commission and ran for City Council twice.

Mayor Dennis is actively involved in civic initiatives, serving on the Live Oak Economic Development Corporation Board, Northeast Partnership, Randolph Metrocom Chamber, and numerous advisory committees, including those for CPS Energy and SAWS. She has held leadership roles such as Chairwoman of the Bexar County Suburban Cities Committee, President of the Texas Municipal League (TML), and Board Chair of

the TML Intergovernmental Risk Pool. Additionally, she contributes to organizations like the National League of Cities Transportation and Infrastructure Committee and the Texas Association of Black City Council Members.

A graduate of Sam Houston High School, Mayor Dennis earned an Associate Degree in Mortuary Science from San Antonio College and is a licensed mortician. She is a proud mother to Christina Dennis and grandmother to Cierra, Chase, and Christine. Her persistence and faith in God inspire her service to the Live Oak community and beyond.

Maggie Titterington was born into a military family and settled in Schertz, TX. She has cultivated deep roots in her community and has actively contributed to the growth of the region.

For 15 years, Maggie has served in a leadership role with The Chamber (Schertz-Cibolo-Selma area), an organization that supports over 620 businesses spanning 21 cities. As President & CEO, her transformative leadership has expanded the Chamber, and secured prestigious 4-star accreditation, placing it in the top 3% in U.S. She also launched the Leadership CORE program, graduating 77 professionals over 11 years, demonstrating her dedication to developing future leaders in her community.

Outside The Chamber, she chairs the Schertz Historical Preservation Society and is a founding member of the Community Advisory Committee for Schertz -Cibolo- Universal City ISD (SCUCISD) and the Northeast Lakeview College (NLC) Friends of Nighthawks President's Advisory Group. For more than 15 years, Maggie has been a strong supporter of NLC and its mission.

Her feedback during college listening sessions has strengthened the college's Strategic Plan and contributed to the next phase of college growth and innovations.

Her strong connections to business leaders have led to monetary support for college scholarships and wrap-around services and led to the opening of NLC's Advocacy Center and ongoing donations to the cause. She actively brings key business leaders together to provide feedback on programming needs to better align with industry demands. Maggie was recognized with the C-Suite Award by San Antonio Business Journal in 2024 and inducted into the SCUCISD Hall of Fame in 2019. She received her Advanced Studies Certificate from the University of Oklahoma in 2013 and her Institute for Organization Management (IOM) distinction in 2017 from the University of Arizona.

# Commencement History and Traditions

**Academic Regalia** - Academic gowns represent a tradition which comes down from the universities of the Middle Ages.

In 1895 in the United States, the Intercollegiate Commission prepared a code specifying the design and color of academic regalia. Under this code, the Bachelor's Gown has long pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The Master's Gown has an oblong sleeve, which gives the impression of a short sleeve. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut, and the front portion has an arc cut away. The Doctor's Gown has bell-shaped sleeves. Doctor's and Master's recipients wear hoods which may represent the color of the college or university from which the degree is received.

Caps are the traditional mortarboard except for the Doctor's degree, where a four-sided velvet tam is optional. Caps from schools with special color gowns, or from foreign universities, may be more distinctive. Holders of all these degrees wear the tassel on the left. Candidates for graduation wear the tassel on the right.

**College Mace** - The mace is a traditional symbol of authority. During the Middle Ages the mace served the practical purpose of protecting the academic procession from local rowdies. Today, the mace is part of the heritage and pageantry of the academic procession.

**AlamoPROMISE** - A last-dollar scholarship program that covers tuition and required fees for current academic year graduates from participating high schools seeking an academic certificate or associate's degree at one of the five Alamo Colleges. These graduates are designated with a white stole.

**Early College High School** – Students graduating from an Early College High School program are represented with a light blue cord.

**Honors** - The Honors designation is represented with a bright yellow cord.

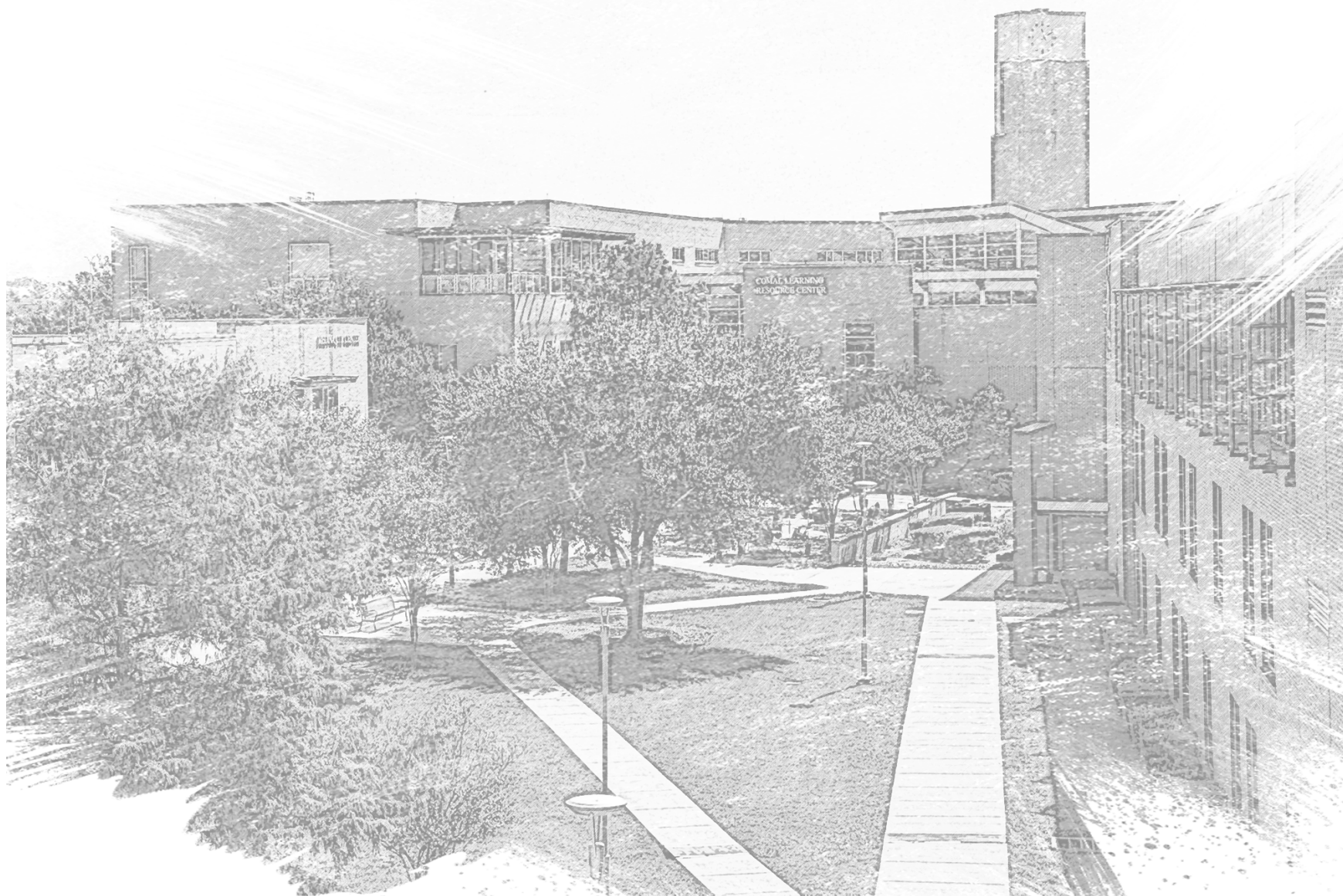
**Honors Academy** - This program encourages NLC students with high scholastic achievement to take on the additional academic rigor of the Honors Academy. Graduates of the Honors Academy will receive Honors Distinction on their transcript.

**National Society of Leadership & Success** - The Society is the largest leadership society in the nation with a mission of building leaders to make a better world. Students complete a leadership program prior to induction and are represented with a grey designation.

**Military Designation** –Students and employees that are active duty or retired military are represented by a red, white, and blue cord.

**Phi Theta Kappa** - Members maintain an overall grade point average of 3.25 or above. These candidates have been inducted and have participated in the dues-paying International Honor Society for two-year college students. Phi Theta Kappa is represented by the gold honor stole.

**Student Government Association** - Members are the official voice of the student body and link between the student body and the administration of the College to improve the quality and value of both the social and educational experience. SGA members are represented by a blue and white cord.
