## Current Collaborations

**What do we mean by collaborations?** We're talking about web-based tools that most likely your students are already familiar with. Students can use resources like [Google Docs](#) to work collaboratively on tasks like group papers or note-taking. This page gives them (and you) an easy place to keep track of those collaborations, and also to set them up without having to swap emails.

To find out more about a particular type of collaboration, click "Start a New Collaboration" and then choose that type in the dropdown list.

## Start a New Collaboration

Collaborate using:

Google Docs is a great place to collaborate on a group project. It's like Microsoft Word, but lets you work together with others on the same file at the same time without having to email it around.

**Warning:** you (and all your collaborators) will need a Google account in order to participate in any Google Docs collaborations.

## Size

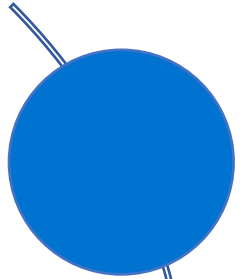
- ❖ The shorter the time period, the smaller the group should be

## Group Contracts

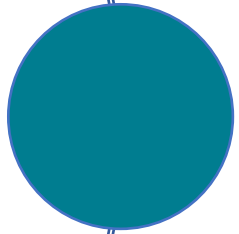
- ❖ Roles, Leadership, “turn in” responsibility, benchmarks with due dates, policies for social loafers.



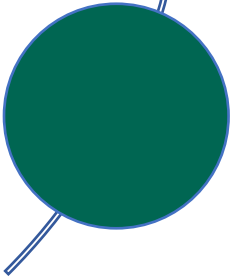
