# COVID Update

- It has been a challenging twenty-three months transitioning between remote, onsite, and hybrid work and learning; during that time we have maintained a commitment to safety and student success.
- On February 7<sup>th</sup>, we transitioned to Level I (Up to 100% Occupancy) in accordance with our Return to Campus Plan.
- This transition has been a success due to the consideration, respect we've shown each other, and the intentional measures we've implemented.
- We ask for your continued diligence, flexibility, and commitment as we continue to meet the emerging needs in our community and our commitments to student access and success.
- At the Level 1 (Up to 100% Occupancy), SPC has reopened its doors to allow a more normal flow of students and employees between our learning and working spaces. As you know, we are no longer conducting "pre-entry" screenings and have transitioned our resources to COVID-19 Screening.



# COVID Screening

## COVID-19 Screening (a.k.a. PCR Testing):

ACD and SPC, in partnership with Community Labs (CL), are collecting samples daily at both the MLK and SW Campuses.

To help all of us meet the mandatory weekly COVID-19 Screening requirement, SPC has opened four stations that will be open Monday through Friday (excluding holidays and closures) from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

- The collection stations are located in the Sutton Learning Center, Center for Health Professions, Applied Science Building, and the Industrial Technology Center (SWC BLDG 1).
- Saturdays only, one station in the William C. Davis Science Building from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

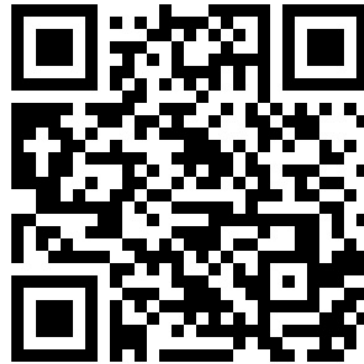
