St. Philip's College is among the oldest and most diverse community colleges in the nation. Opening March 1, 1898, the school began as a weekend sewing class for six black girls, taught by Miss Alice G. Cowan, a missionary with the Episcopal Church. Today, it is a comprehensive, multi-campus institution dedicated to meeting the educational needs of San Antonio's growing community.

SPC is the only college in the U.S. with the distinct dual designation as a Historically Black College and Hispanic Serving Institution. SPC has an enrollment of approximately *14,281 credit students per semester and approximately *2,766 dual credit, early college high school, and academy students annually. (*Enrollment numbers as of Fall 2023)

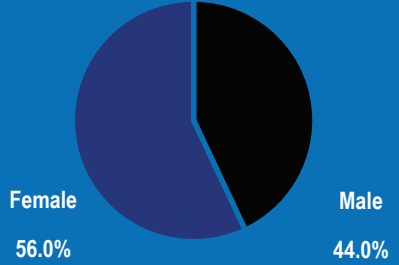

Bachelor of Applied Technology Cybersecurity

OSA



The Cyber First Responders Occupational Skills Award is designed to prepare first responders to effectively and efficiently act to counter cyber-based terror attacks against our nation's network-based infrastructure. With this award, you may seek jobs such as **Cyber Incident Handler**.

OSA



The CompTIA Security + Certification Preparation Occupational Skills Award is an international certification that proves competency in system security, network infrastructure, access control and organizational security. With this award, you may seek jobs such as **IT Security Compliance Analyst**.

OSA



The CompTIA Linux+ Certification Preparation Occupational Skills Award is a great way to start your career in IT. Earning certifications shows not only that you have the right knowledge and skills to do the job, but that you are dedicated to your career. With this award, you may seek jobs such as **Linux System Administrator**.

LEV1



The Information Technology Cybersecurity Specialist Level I Certificate prepares students to design, implement and secure computer networks and can be completed in one year face-to-face or fully online. With this award, you may seek jobs such as **Information Security Analyst**.

AAS



The Information Technology Cybersecurity Specialist, Associate of Applied Science degree prepares students to respond to security breaches, cyber attacks and, in some cases, data gathering for evidence to be used in prosecuting cyber crime. Students learn to design, implement and secure computer networks. The program of study for the associate of applied science degree is 60 semester credit hours and you can earn several occupational skills awards and a level 1 certificate while pursuing this degree. Information Technology Cybersecurity Specialist, A.A.S. is offered face-to-face or fully online. With this award, you may seek jobs such as **Cyber Security Analyst / Cyber Security Specialist**.

BAT



Bachelor of Applied Technology (BAT) in Cybersecurity

The Bachelor of Applied Technology (BAT) in Cybersecurity degree plan is an additional 60 semester credit hours above an associate degree. The combined total of 120 semester credit hours will qualify students to receive a Bachelor of Applied Technology in Cybersecurity Degree. With this award, you may seek jobs such as **Information Technology Project Managers (Median Salary: \$91,635)**, **Security Management Specialists (Median Salary: \$73,620)** and **Database Administrators (Median Salary: \$100,307)**.
